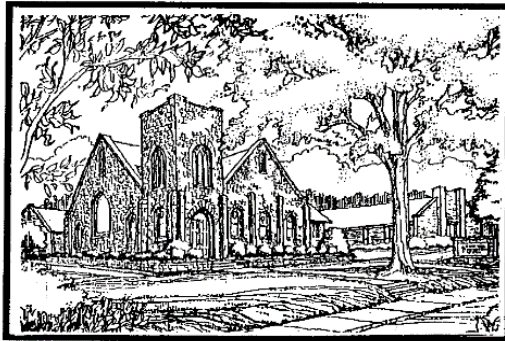

Confession of Sin
